

NEWS FROM THE PCC

Here is the summary of things discussed at the July 2020 PCC meeting. Alan Stuart, Secretary

Covid-19 – All church services and events are still suspended. Other new projects and some training have also been suspended at present, these include:

- New Worshipping Community (NWC) – Paused for 12 months
- Defibrillator – Delayed but this is being pursued
- Safeguarding training – current certificates have been extended
- Week One Walks & Girls' Night Out are paused

Hope into Action – We have entered Service Level Agreement with Hope into Action and are now trying to identify a suitable property to purchase

The 'Real Life' course will run again in September, hopefully face-to-face but maybe not initially, anyone interested in attending this course should contact the Church Office

APCM – Following information from the diocese, our APCM is likely to be held on the evening of Wednesday 14th October (via Zoom).

Re-opening of church – Plans are being made to partially re-open church in September, more information on this when it's available.

Private Prayer – These will run until the end of July and then be paused during August. As we hope to have a partial re-opening of church in September, they may not resume, there has been a very low attendance at these.

Security – Additional security is being provided for the church Office as Ann works alone – and issues of anti-social behaviour in the car park are being addressed

Church Hall – We may be able to start taking some booking again in August following a risk assessment

PCC – The current PCC members will continue to serve until our APCM in October.
