If you have concerns about possible abuse (including allegations):

- 1. In an emergency, respond immediately. Call 999 for the emergency services.
- 2. Consult the person to whom you are responsible e.g. leader of your group, or the Safeguarding Coordinator, or your incumbent.
- 3. Decide together whether to seek advice or to make an immediate referral.
- 4. Make a record of what happened, your concerns and your actions. Sign and date it and pass it on to the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser:
